Painfully, they leave them at the door of an orphanage or in the market place unattended. Back in April, we had the privilege of meeting two nuns who, along with some friends, are running two orphanages. They work all day as nurses to raise money to feed the children. 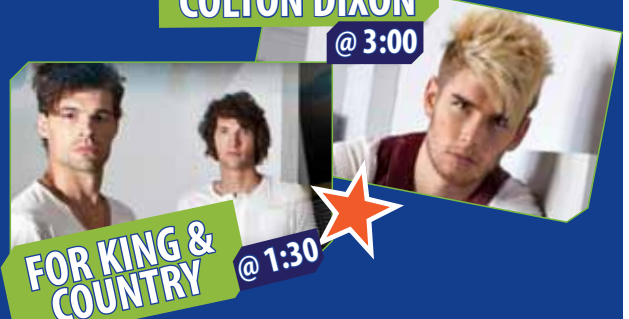
